

ORDINANCE NUMBER 1 (2007)

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL COURT OF RECORD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF ECKLEY:

Section 1: A qualified municipal court of record, as such court is defined by Section 13-10-102 of the Colorado Revised Statutes, is hereby established for the Town of Eckley.

Section 2: The municipal court of record shall hear and try all alleged violations of ordinance provisions of the Town of Eckley.

Section 3: The municipal court of record shall maintain a verbatim record of the proceedings and evidence at trials by either electric devices or stenographic means.

Section 4: The judge of the municipal court of record shall have been admitted to, and currently licensed in, the practice of law in Colorado.

Section 5: The Town of Eckley's municipal court not of record shall cease to exist upon the first day of operations of the Town's municipal court of record.

Section 6: The adoption of this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public safety for the Town of Eckley, and shall be effective upon adoption.


