

Code of Ordinances

Town of Eckley, Colo.

ORDINANCE NO. 25

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ECKLEY, COLORADO,
AS FOLLOWS:

SEC. 26-1. ADOPTION. - Pursuant to Chapter 139, Article 34, C.R.S., 1963, there is hereby adopted for the purpose of regulating traffic within the Town of Eckley, that certain ordinance known as the "Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities, 1966" officially approved, adopted and published as such by the Colorado Highway Safety Council and hereinafter referred to as the "Municipal Traffic Code" of which three (3) copies are now filed in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Eckley and may be inspected during regular business hours, the same being adopted as if set out at length.

Sec. 26-2. PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS. The following penalties, herewith set forth in full, shall apply to the provisions of the Municipal Traffic Code herein adopted:

(a) It is unlawful for any person to violate any of the provisions of the Municipal Traffic Code and any such violation shall be punishable as in hereinafter provided.

(b) Every person convicted of a violation of any provision of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than three hundred dollars (\$300) or by imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days.

Sec. 27-1. APPLICATION OF ORDINANCE. - (a) This ordinance shall apply to every street, alley, sidewalk or sidewalk area, driveway, park, and to every other public way or public parking area, either within or outside the corporate limits of this municipality, the use of which this municipality has jurisdiction and authority to regulate.

(b) The provisions of sections 5-1, 5-2, 5-11, and 23-3 of this ordinance respectively concerning careless driving, reckless driving, unauthorized devices and accident investigation shall apply not only on streets and highways but elsewhere within this municipality.

Sec. 27-2. EFFECT OF ORDINANCE. - If any part or parts of this ordinance are for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this ordinance. The Town Council hereby declares that it would have passed this ordinance and each part or parts, thereof, irrespective of the fact that anyone part or parts be declared invalid or unconstitutional.

Sec. 27-3. REPEAL - All former traffic ordinances of this municipality are hereby repealed and all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed except that this repeal shall not affect or prevent the prosecution or punishment of any person for any act done or committed in violation of any ordinance hereby repealed prior to the taking effect of this ordinance.

Sec. 27-4. CERTIFICATE OF ORDINANCE. - The Town Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance as published and cause the same to be certified for adoption.

Sec. 27-5. SHORT TITLE. - This ordinance may be known and cited as the Municipal Traffic Ordinance.

Sec. 27-6. That at least three (3) copies of the Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities, 1966, are on file in the office of Town Clerk of the Town of Eckley, Colorado, Yuma County, State of

Colorado, and may be inspected by any interested person at any time during regular business hours.

Sec. 27-7. That pursuant to and in compliance with Chapter 139, Article 34, Section 3 of Colorado Revised Statutes, 1963, as amended, the Town Clerk of the Town of Eckley, is hereby authorized and directed to publish Notice of a public hearing on the adoption and enactment of the "Model Traffic Code for Colorado Municipalities, 1966" to the extent and pursuant to the schedule for such publications prescribed in 139-34-3 of Colorado Revised Statutes, 1963.
