

ORDINANCE NO. 1, 2025

AN ORDINANCE RE-NAMING PORTER AVENUE TO PORTER STREET, RE-NAMING KANSAS AVENUE TO KANSAS STREET AND RE-NAMING OHIO AVENUE TO OHIO STREET, WITHIN THE TOWN OF ECKLEY, COLORADO

WHEREAS, the March 16, 1920 Plat of the Town of Eckley, recorded at Book A, Page 51 of the Yuma County Records, ("1920 Plat") describes all North-South streets within the Town of Eckley as "Avenues" instead of "Streets":

WHEREAS, historically thereafter, Porter Avenue, Kansas Avenue Clark Avenue and Ohio Avenue that are shown on the 1920 Plat have been commonly referred to within the Town of Eckley as "streets" instead of "Avenues", and the Town of Eckley wishes to officially rename these as streets;

WHEREAS, Section 31-15-103, C.R.S. authorizes the Board of Trustees (the "Board") of the Town of Eckley, Colorado (the "Town") to make and publish ordinances which are necessary and proper to provide for the safety, preserve the health, promote the prosperity, and improve the morals, order, comfort, and convenience of the Town and the inhabitants thereof; and

WHEREAS, Section 31-15-702(1)(a)(VII), C.R.S. authorizes the Board to regulate the number of houses and lots and to name and change the name of any street or other public place; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Eckley has mailed all property owners (including all condominium and whose parcel or unit is upon, adjacent to, accessed by, crossed or otherwise intersected by the avenues and streets described herein, as listed in the records of Yuma County Assessor with advance notice of the Public hearing held October 7th 2025 at the Town of Eckley Town Hall at which the Board has considered the changes made herein.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF ECKLEY, COLORADO:

1. Porter Avenue is hereby re-named to Porter Street, Kansas Avenue is hereby re-named Kansas Street, and Ohio Avenue is hereby re-named Ohio Street, and Clark Ave is re-named Clark St within the Town of Eckley, Colorado; and all other streets retain street designation.
2. All prior acts, ordinances, resolutions, codes, or parts thereof, by the Town in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby amended with respect to the names set forth in the paragraph above.

4. Street name signs reflecting the changes approved herein shall be placed by the Town of Eckley within 60 days of the effective date of this ordinance.
5. A copy of this ordinance shall be sent to the Yuma County Manager, the Yuma County Assessor, the Yuma County Clerk and Recorder's Office, the Yuma County GIS Department, the Yuma County Sheriff, the Eckley fire Department, shall be sent to any other appropriate emergency response agency, to the US Postal Service, to any private entities who enter into a monetary contract with Yuma County for address and street update information, to the Colorado Department of Transportation. A copy of this ordinance will be recorded in the Yuma County Clerk and Recorder's real estate records.
6. If any section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Ordinance is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of, and shall be severable from, the remaining portions of this Ordinance. The Board hereby declares that it would have adopted this Ordinance and each part or parts hereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts may be declared unconstitutional or invalid.




